

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

SECTION 16A

THE COUNTY OF DEVON (TEMPORARY RESTRICTION) (THE GRIZZFEST AND THE GRIZZLY, SEATON) ORDER 2023

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC, ONE WAY & PARKING

**NOTICE** is hereby given that Devon County Council has made the above titled order.

From **SATURDAY 4 MARCH 2023**  
for a maximum of 3 days

Anticipated Finish **SUNDAY 5 MARCH 2023**

No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed on the sections of Affected Roads except for access to land or premises on or adjacent to those lengths of roads.

Roads affected – **Saturday 04 March between 10.00 and 17.00 and Sunday 05 March between 07.00 and 18.00. The Esplanade, Beach Road and Trevelyan Road, Seaton.**

The alternative, signed, route for vehicles will be via - Harbour Road

Roads affected – **Sunday 05 March**

**Between 10.00 and 17.00 – Castle Hill, Seaton**

The alternative signed route for vehicles will be via Harbour Road, The Underfleet, Fore Street, Cross Street and Beer Road.

**Between 10.30 and 11.30 – Beer Road, Seaton and New Road, Beer**

The alternative signed route for vehicles will be via B3172, A3052 and B3174

**Between 10.30 and 11.30 – Long Hill, Beer**

The alternative signed route for vehicles will be via New Road and The Causeway

**Between 10.30 and 11.30 – Fore Street, Beer**

The alternative signed route for vehicles will be via The Causeway, Townsend, Underleys, Park Road and Clapps Lane

**Between 10.30 and 16.30 – Common Lane, Beer**

The alternative signed route for vehicles will be via The Meadows, Clapps Lane and South Down Road.

**Between 11.00 and 15.30 – Lockseys lane, Branscombe**

The alternative signed route for southbound vehicles will be via A3052, Bulstone lane, Northern Lane, Berry Hill and C67.

The alternative signed route for northbound vehicles will be via C67 and Sellers Wood Hill.

**Between 11.00 and 15.30 – Road known as Northern Lane, Branscombe**

The alternative signed route for westbound vehicles will be via C67, Sellers Wood Hill, A3052 and Bulstone Lane.

The alternative signed route for eastbound vehicles will be via Berry Hill and C67.

No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in a direction other than that indicated by the one-Way traffic signs.

**Roads affected – Sunday 05 March between 10.00 and 17.00**

**Harbour Road, Seaton** from its junction with Underfleet and Marine Place - No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in a **Westerly** direction.

The alternative signed route for vehicles will be via Underfleet, Fore Street, Cross Street, Beer Road and Sea Hill.

**Marine Place, Seaton** – from its junction with Harbour Road and the Roundabout at Fishermans Gap - No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in a **Southerly** direction.

The alternative signed route for vehicles will be via Harbour Road, The Underfleet, Fore Street, Cross Street, Queens Street, Beer Road and Sea Hill.

**North side of Fishermans Gap Roundabout** - No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in a **Westerly** direction.

The alternative signed route for vehicles will be via Harbour Road, The Underfleet, Fore Street, Cross Street, Queens Street, Beer Road and Sea Hill

**Roads affected – Sunday 05 March between 12.00 and 15.30**

**C67, Branscombe** – No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in an **Easterly** direction

The alternative signed route for vehicles will be via – Berry Hill

**Berry Hill, Branscombe** – No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in a **Westerly** direction

The alternative signed route for vehicles will be via – C67

No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the section of Affected Roads.

**Saturday 04 March between 12.00 and 17.00. Sunday 05 March between 07.00 and 17.00 - Roads Affected – Harbour Road, Seaton** from its junction with Trevelyan Road and the entrance to the Axe Yacht Club.

**Saturday 04 March between 10.00 and 17.00. Sunday 05 March between 07.00 and 18.00 - Road Affected – The Esplanade, Seaton.**

**Sunday 05 March between 07.00 and 17.00 - Roads Affected – Beer Road and New Road** between Cliff Field Gardens and its junction with Clinton Way Footpath Sign.

**Sunday 05 March between 10.00 and 15.30 - Roads Affected – C67 Road from Higher Barn to the Old Cider House, Branscombe** from a point 50M West of the junction with Locksey's Lane to a point 50M East of its junction with Mill Lane.

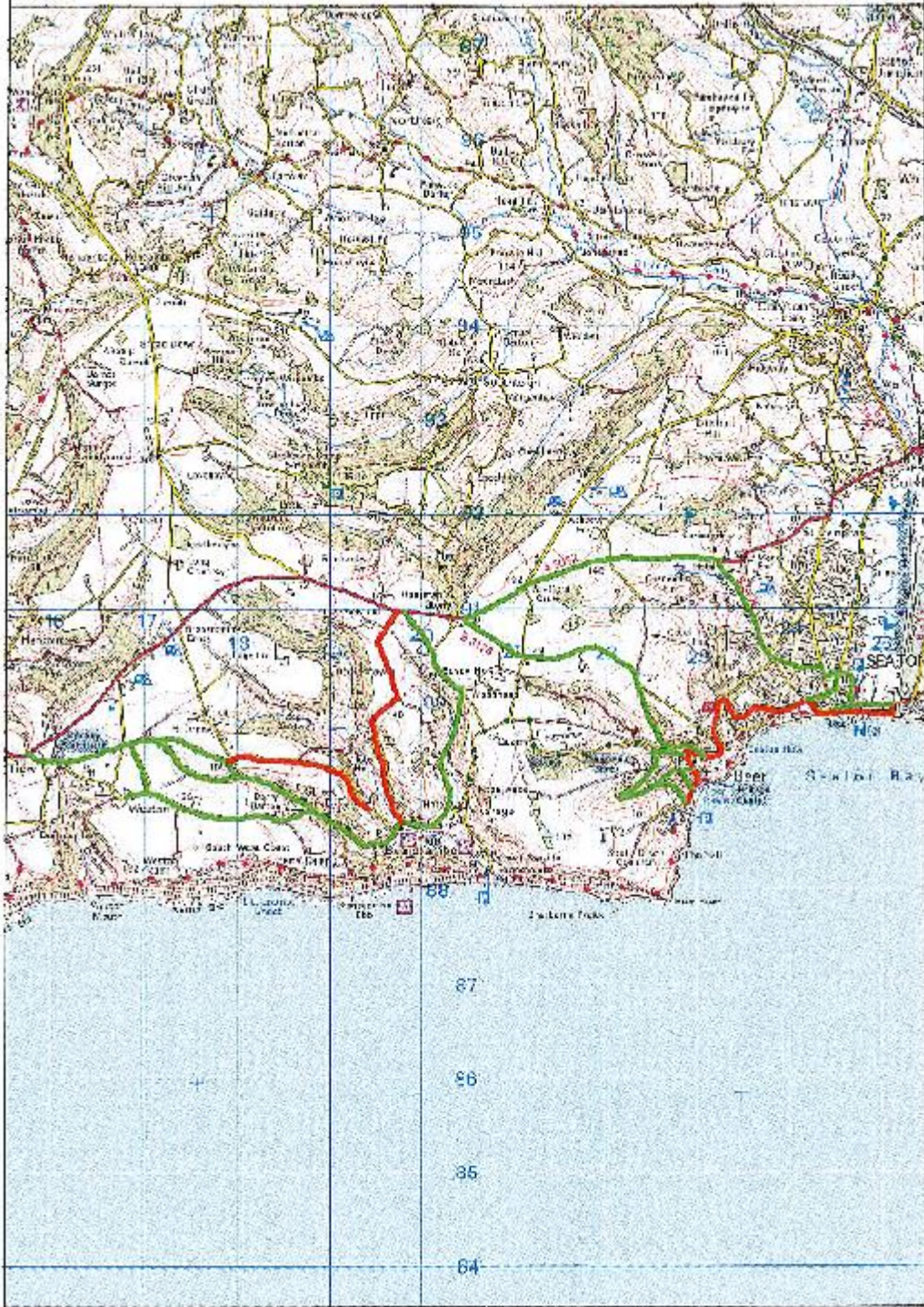
