for a maximum of 18 months

Anticipated Finish **SATURDAY 20 JANUARY 2024**

No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed on the sections of Affected Roads.

**BEER ROAD, SEATON , (FROM THE JUNCTION OF B3172 TO BEER ROAD TO CAR
PARK ENTRANCE)**

The alternative, signed, route for vehicles will be via - WESTBOUND - BEER ROAD, SEA
HILL, CASTLE HILL, BEER ROAD

EASTBOUND - BEER ROAD, MARLPIT LANE, SEATON DOWN HILL, QUEEN STREET,
MANOR ROAD, FORE STREET, CROSS STREET, BEER ROAD

This temporary restriction is considered necessary to enable -

**A REINFORCEMENT SCHEME TO UPGRADE THE OVERHEAD LINE AND UNSAFE
POLE NETWORK, BY PUTTING THE MAJORITY OF THE NETWORK
UNDERGROUND.**
