

## Parking Information for Seaton **Spring/Summer** From 1<sup>st</sup> April to 1<sup>st</sup> November 2024

### East Devon District Council Car Parks

Car park: **Seaton Jurassic Underfleet (West)** (max stay 24 hours but gate locked at 8pm)

Minimum payment: £1.00 (30 minutes)

Each hour up to 3 hours: £2.00 per hour

4 hours up to 24 hours: £8.00 total

Motorhomes permitted between 8am and 10pm – no overnight parking

Car park: **Seaton Jurassic Long Stay Car Park** (maximum stay 24 hours, gates open)

Minimum payment: £1.00 (30 minutes)

Each hour up to 3 hours: £2.00 per hour

4 hours up to 24 hours: £8.00 total

Motorhomes permitted between 8am and 10pm – no overnight parking

Car park: **Orchard Road Short Stay** (maximum stay 24 hours, gates open)

Minimum payment: 75p (30 minutes)

Each hour up to 6 hours: £1.50 per hour

6 hours up to 24 hours: £10.00 total

Motorhomes permitted between 8am and 10pm – no overnight parking

7-day (24 hour) parking permits accepted

Car park: **Town Hall Marsh Road Long Stay** (maximum stay 24 hours)

Minimum payment: 50p (30 minutes)

Each hour up to 6 hours: £1.00 per hour

6 hours up to 24 hours: £6.00 total

Car park: **Seaton Jurassic Coach Park** – Coaches Only, 24 Hours)

Minimum payment: £1.00 per hour

10 hours up to 24 hours: £10.00 total maximum payment

## Privately Operated Car Parks

### Tesco

Free parking up to 1.5 hours, there are cameras monitoring this car park.

### Aldi (Former Co-Op Car Park)

1.5 hours free parking, there are cameras monitoring this car park.

### Premier Inn Customer Car Park

No Parking (For guests staying at the Premier Inn only. Cameras operate on the entrance)

### The Grove Car Park (Next Door to Aldi and Jubilee Court) Operated by Smart Parking

Beware – although this car park is marketed as the cheapest in Seaton, there are CCTV cameras which record vehicle registration numbers and the precise time of entry and exit to and from the car park. The operators are very zealous at issuing parking fines of £100.

Do not drive into, then out, of this car park without paying the minimum fee or you will be fined £100.

## Devon County Council on Street Parking on the Seafont

The parking bays along the seafont in Seaton are owned by Devon County Council and there are payment machines located at regular intervals along the seafont. Charges apply between 1<sup>st</sup> April and 31<sup>st</sup> October, parking is free during the winter months. You will need to enter your car registration number into the machine, therefore the tickets are non-transferable.

Payment can be made by coins, or by debit or credit card via the RINGO app.

Between the hours of 9am and 6pm:

Up to 3 minutes	40p
Up to 1 hour	£1.50
Up to 2 hours	£4.00
Up to 3 hours	£6.00
Up to 4 hours	£8.00

Maximum stay is 4 hours - no return within one hour.

After 6pm parking is free



There are several dedicated disabled parking bays on the seafont which are free of charge for all blue badge holders, 24/7.

Disabled blue badge holders can also park in the non-disabled bays and still benefit from free parking.
