T1: Oak - crown reduction by 1m and thinning by 10% by removing small branches.

4 Couchill Drive, Seaton EX12 2JG

Oak: Reduce the largest and most dominant stems arising from previous topping cuts by removal of the largest stem (axis) at first forking event making pruning cuts averaging 50-100mm in diameter. Reduce retained stems by 1-1.5m using reduction via thinning techniques where retained stems protrude from edge of crown. Test integrity of dead wood, remove loose dead wood and shorten stable dead wood to 1m stubs.
