**Drainage repair works**  
**Boshill Hill A3052 / B3172, Axmouth**

Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> December 2025

Devon Highways will be carrying out drainage repair works on A3052 Boshill Hill and the junction with B3172, Axmouth, from Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> January – Friday 30<sup>th</sup> January 2026. The highway requires maintenance and these essential repairs will help restore the surface and improve safety. Our working hours are 07.00 – 17.00.

The map below shows the work area in **green**. Please note the orange dots are a means to attach the lines to the map, they have no other significance.




**Access**

- A3052 Boshill Hill will remain open under a two-way traffic signals system. Delays should be expected.
- For safety reasons, the work section on the B3172 will be closed for all through traffic from Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> – Friday 16<sup>th</sup> January.

Access queries should be directed to our Contractor or an operative on site who will be glad to assist. Access for emergency vehicles will always be maintained.

Please see the road closure and work area highlighted in **red** on the map below, the signed diversion routes are shown in **blue**. Drivers with local knowledge may use alternative routes but these will not be advertised for safety reasons.



Any changes to the start date or duration will be shown on advisory signs on site. We will do our best to complete the work quickly and minimise disruption. Your co-operation and understanding are greatly appreciated.
